

Arcadian rhythm

Built with future generations in mind, this reimagined Irish farmhouse reveals a contemporary take on traditional values

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Living room Suspended above this space is a giant 'Moon' pendant by Davide Groppi that measures two metres in diameter – it's so big it had to be craned in through the roof. The equally oversized sofa is the 'Connery' by Rodolfo Dordani for Minotti. It is joined by a wooden coffee table by Louise Liljencrantz for The Invisible Collection, a 'Hippo' lounge chair by Norm11, and a marble plinth that was designed by Kingston Lafferty Design and made by Miller Brothers Stone. It is all placed on top of a rug from Restoration Hardware, which lends some cosiness to the limed oak flooring from Trunk – the same material is used on the ceiling cladding. On the back wall hangs a painting by Struan Teague from Richeldis Fine Art Gallery. This brass floor lamp in front of it is the 'Metropolis' by Jan Garncarek. Sheer curtains, made using fabric from Clarke & Clarke's 'Natura' collection, allow natural light to lend the whole room a magical glow ▶
